

WebDCB 'Trusted Site' Settings



The following instructions may assist you in the establishment of WebDCB.com as a "trusted site." A trusted site is a Web site that you trust not to damage your computer.

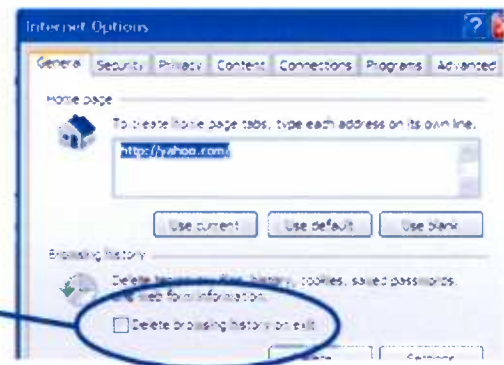
If you set the security level of your internet browser to 'High,' you may be blocking certain features of some web sites that you may wish to access. To fully access WebDCB, you can add the URL to your Trusted Sites list or change your security level to 'Medium' or lower. When using one of the higher settings, you need to add the Web application URLs to your Trusted Sites list.

After making adjustments to your web browser's settings, you will be asked to obtain a Secure Access Code one more time. This is due to the fact that the web browser has already deleted the registration info.

Internet Explorer™ Browser Settings *Version 6.x, Version 7.x and Version 8.x*

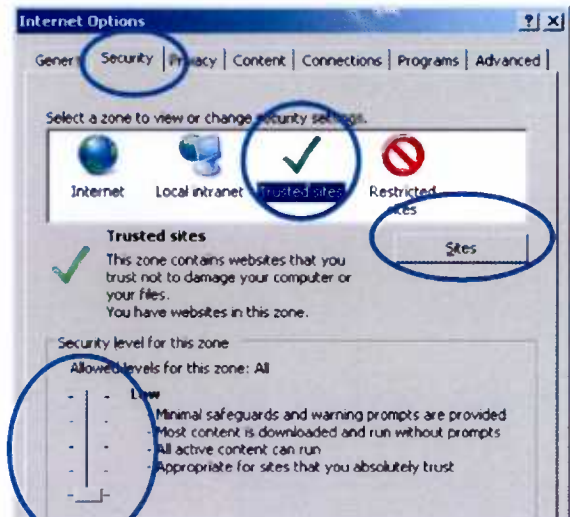
- Open Internet Explorer
- Click the Tools menu
- Click Internet Options

• If you are using Internet Explorer™ 8.x there is one thing that you must check before continuing. Make sure the computer does not have the 'Delete Browsing History on Exit' marked.



You will have one of two methods to adjust the security settings in Internet Explorer.
Method #1 is for non-custom settings.
Method #2 is for those customer that have customized their security settings.
Both sets of instructions are on the following page.

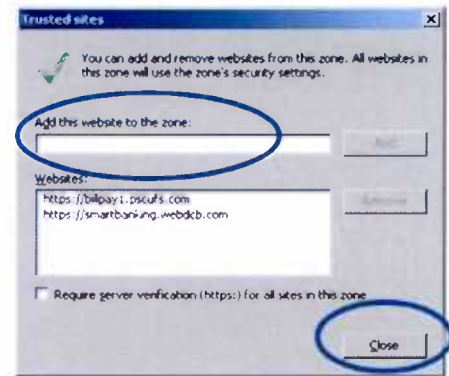
- Click the Security tab
- Select Trusted Sites if it is not already highlighted
- Click the Sites button



- Type the addresses above in the Add this Website to the zone: box.
- Click Add. This will move it to the box below.
- Click Close

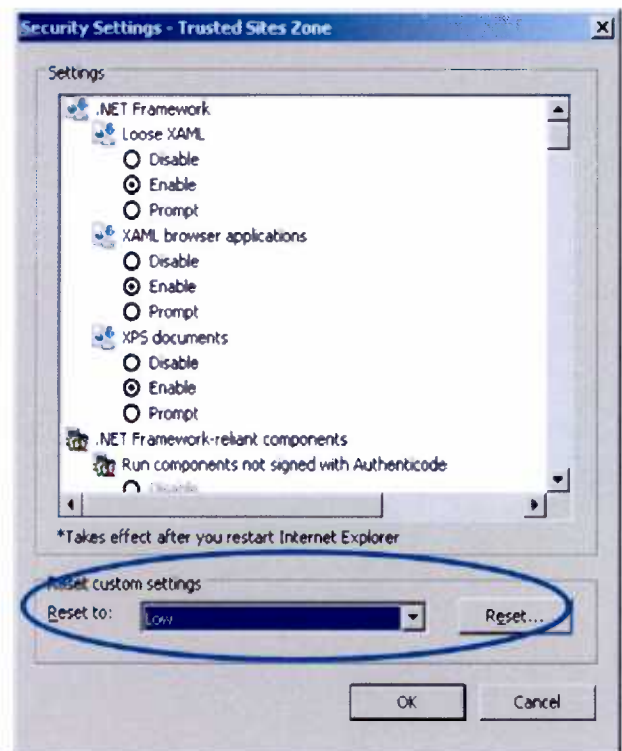
Method #1

- Consider the Security Setting you currently have. If you have it set on 'High,' you may want to try lowering the setting.
- To change the security level, just grab the slider bar and move it the desired level.
- Click OK to exit
- Close out of all Internet Explorer windows. This is required for the new settings to take effect.
- This completes the browser setup



Method #2

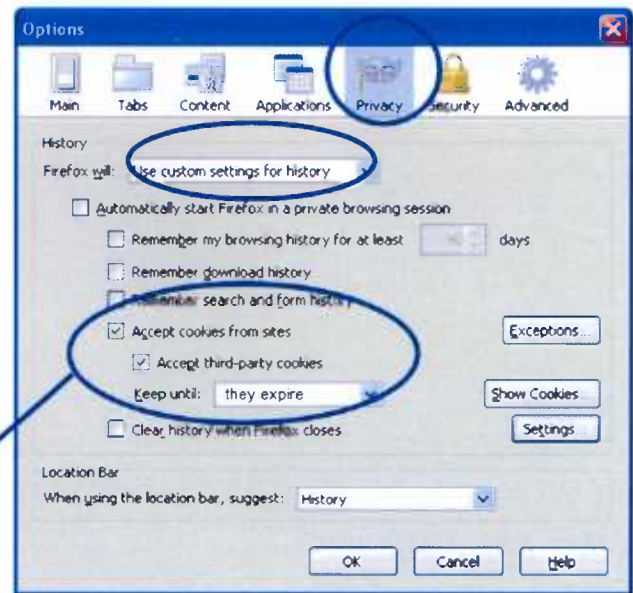
- If it states Custom click the Custom level button.
- At the bottom where it states Reset Custom Settings Reset to: Low
- Click Reset and they will be asked to confirm this action.
- Click OK to exit.
- Click OK to exit
- Close out of all Internet Explorer windows. This is required for the new settings to take effect.
- This completes the browser setup



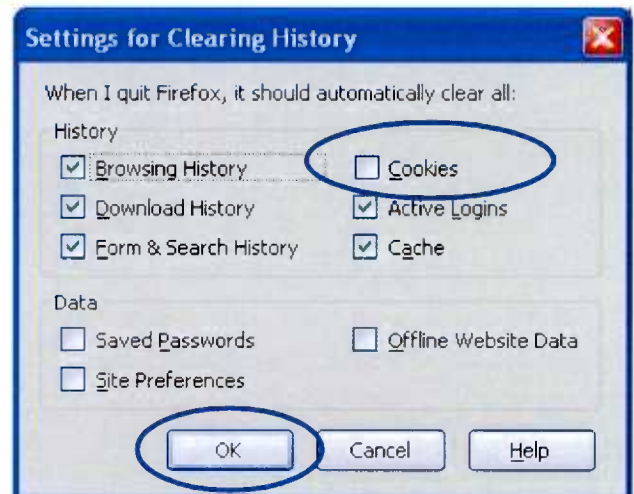
Firefox™ Browser Settings

Version 3.x for Windows and Apple Macintosh

- Open the Firefox™ Web Browser
- This is the only step that varies between Apple Macintosh™ and Windows™
 - For Windows™ the User will Click the Tools menu then Options
 - For Apple Macintosh™ the user will Click the Firefox™ menu then Preferences
- Click the Privacy Icon at the top.
- Verify that Firefox™ will: 'Use custom settings for history' is set in the drop down
- Verify that Accept Cookies from sites is checked
- Verify that Accept third-party Cookies is checked
- Verify Keep Until is set to 'They Expire'



- If the computer has Clear History when Firefox™ closes checked. Click Settings. Another box will appear where you can remove the check mark from cookies. Click OK



- Click the Exceptions button
- Another box will appear. Enter both of the following addresses:
 - smartbanking.webdcb.com Click Allow
 - billpay1.pscufs.com Click Allow
- Click Close
- Click OK to close out of the options window
- Close All Firefox™ windows including Webmail and other sites. This is required for the new settings to take effect.
- Firefox is now setup
